

His teacher will set his iPad to Guided Access for ten minutes, so that he can focus on writing for ten minutes, and then have a break.



Set Guided Access Passcode Set Passcode Cancel es UE Enter a passcode Tap Passcode Settings. Tap Set Guided Access Passcode. Enter a passcode. Set up the page so that the student is ready to work. Triple click the home button. Guided Access will begin.

SET BC

Tap **Touch** (bottom centre) to block access to certain areas of the screen. Once the switch is toggled on (green), draw a circle around the area of the screen you would like to prevent access to. These shaded areas can then be moved around by dragging, or deleted by tapping the x.



Tap **Time Limit Options** to set a time limit for Guided Access.
